SUBJECT: Cadet Challenge (events may be modified or eliminated due to COVID-19 restrictions)

One of the most important services to our nation performed by the JROTC program is to improve the physical fitness of our Cadets and to develop in them an appreciation of its importance. One method of accomplishing this task is through the Cadet challenge program.

Cadet Challenge is a competitive type physical program where as squad, platoon, and company size units within the organization compete in the following five events:

1. Curl-ups (perform as many as possible in one minute)
2. Pull-ups (perform as many as possible- no time limit)
3. V-Sit and Reach (reach as far past the baseline as possible)
4. One-mile run/walk (run/walk a mile as fast as possible)
5. Shuttle Run (run 30 foot course twice; run as fast as possible)

SUBJECT: Required Uniforms and Extracurricular Activities Update

JROTC Instructors will issue the U.S. Army Cadet (Class B) uniform to all Cadets during school hours within the first month of school. After fitting the uniforms, JROTC instructors will take any uniforms requiring alterations to a contracted alteration shop. These uniforms should be returned to the Cadet in less than a week. Cadets will ensure uniforms in their possession are properly cleaned, maintained, and pressed before each wearing on designated uniform days. Class B uniform days will alternate weekly on Tuesdays and Fridays (alternating weekly with Physical Training (PT) days). This schedule allows Cadets on Hybrid plans to wear their uniform twice per month. Virtual students will receive guidance on the uniform wear requirements weekly. Students on campus will wear the uniform with pride all day at school on designated uniform days.

Cadets that are not in uniform on a prescribed uniform wear day will receive a zero grade for uniform wear that day. If uniforms are worn but do not meet the standards established by regulation and applicable policies, Cadets may receive a reduced uniform wear grade for that day. If a Cadet is absent on a uniform day, he or she must coordinate with the JROTC Instructors to establish an alternate uniform wear day. Class B Uniform wear is 30% of the Cadet's grade.

The required PT uniform consists of grey athletic shorts and a navy-blue moisture-wicking Bulls Battalion PT T-shirt. PT uniforms are available for purchase (\$25.00) from the JROTC Instructor. Tuesdays and Fridays are Physical Training (PT) days (alternating weekly with the uniform wear days). During PT, there will be thorough stretching, rigorous Army-style PT or sports, and the appropriate cool down. For Cadets or families with difficulty purchasing the required uniform please contact your Cadet's JROTC Instructor. Cadets must bring/wear their PT uniforms on their respective PT day unless directed otherwise. Failure to bring proper attire will not excuse the Cadet from participating in PT. PT uniform wear and participation is 25% of the Cadets Grade.

COVID-19 limitations throughout the district prevent us from determining which extracurricular teams will be functioning at this time. With that said, Cadets will have many practical experiences and opportunities to step up as leaders in the classroom and in other areas of the program. Color Guard is the one team we will continue to have given we have pending Color Guard taskings in the community. Once it has been determined which additional teams will be permitted, and in close coordination with school administration, we will establish afternoon practice schedules. Practices last approximately one hour on the designated days. If we have multiple teams, practices will occur on opposite days so Cadets can be on multiple teams if desired.

RESPONSIBILITY FOR GOVERNMENT PROPERTY

The lawful authority by which a student holds Government property is contingent upon his/her actual regular attendance in school, and his/her enrollment in JROTC. These conditions are limited to the period of the school year only. A student's lawful right to hold Government property ceases when he/she quits school, is suspended or disenrolled from JROTC, and at the end of the school year. Under the conditions just mentioned, the student as required by Federal Law must turn over upon demand from proper authority all Government property in his/her possession, or the equivalent in cash. The requirement of the law is found in the Reserve Statutes of the United States (CC35: R.S. 3438: ACTS May 30, 1908, c235, 35 Stat 556; Mar 4, 1909; c321, 35 Stat 1905). It reads as follows:

EXTRACT: "Whoever having charges, possession, custody, or control of any money or other public property used or to be used in the military service, with intent to defraud the United States or willfully to conceal such money or other property shall deliver or cause to be delivered to any person having authority to receive the same, any amount of such money or other property, less than for which he/she received a certificate or hand receipt, shall be fined not more than five thousand dollars, or imprisoned not more than five years or both."

Parent or guardians who sign an agreement with reference to the return of Government property are, therefore, responsible and jointly liable to the provisions of the law the same as the student.

AGREEMENT OF RESPONSIBILITY

I hereby agree to be responsible to the Board of Education of Manatee County, Florida, for such articles of Government clothing and equipment as may be issued to the above-mentioned student, in accordance with law, and signed for by the student for his/her use as a member of JROTC. I further agree to be responsible for any property not returned in good condition, fair wear and tear expected, at the end of the school year or upon the student's separation from JROTC, or upon demand of the school authorities.

Statement Required by Privacy Act of 1974
